

Let's visit Brežice city



Just few kilometers from Terme Čatež is standing historically important city Brežice, which was until 1945, the town on the border of three countries. You can find out more, if you attend the morning trip to the city.

We will meet in front of Urška confectionery. After short presentation of Terme Čatež, we will go by bus to the city Brežice. After driving through the bridge of the longest river in Slovenia, river Sava, our exploration of the town, which was first mentioned in 12. century, will begin in the city center, just in front of the medieval Castle Brežice, famous for a unique example of baroque secular painting in Slovenia, now called Knightss' hall. From there we will walk into the most beautiful old craftsman street named Gasa and find out why even in these days, Brežice is called a craft and trade city. Main street of neo-Renaissance houses will tell us the story about the cultural revolution of the Slovenian nation in the 19. century and the importance of the city in the 2. World War, when Brežice was the southernmost city of the German Reich. The story of the Franciscans and their great impact on population development will be presented just in front of the former monastery – today's Grammar School. City walk will end just in front of the technological heritage – city monument, Water Tower. The remainder of time can be used for a visit of the Water Tower and Knightss' hall in Castle Brežice (register in advance), or you can relax in one of the cafes in Brežice and enjoy the city view.

On the way back to Terme Čatež we will pass the oldest bridge across rivers Sava and Krka, where two spectacular film scenes took place with an actor Jackie Cain in 1986.
